World Book Day gives us the opportunity to celebrate the great books that we have already read and inspire pupils to deepen their love for reading even more. This year in Mountnorris, we will be celebrating World Book Day on Thursday 7^{th} March in the following ways:

Dressing Up in Your Pyjamas or as a Favourite Book Character - Pupils will not be expected to wear uniform on World Book Day but instead should come dressed up as a character from their favourite book or wearing their pyjamas. Pupils should bring the book that their character is from and will be given the opportunity in class to showcase their costume and talk about why they chose it.
